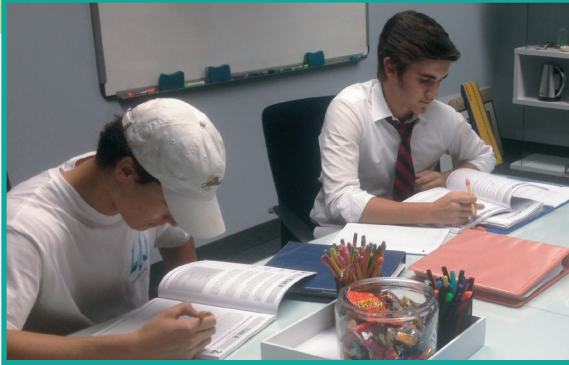

AGES: Seventh Grade through adults welcome!

CLASS SIZE: Classes vary in size from a minimum of four to a maximum of ten students.

REGISTRATION: To register for the class, complete the student registration form and mail or email it to us. Call the office if you need to discuss schedule related needs. All scheduling changes must be approved.

COST: One class is \$900. A \$450 nonrefundable deposit for each student is due with the registration form.

MAKE-UPS: Students must coordinate with their instructor.

LEARNING DIFFERENCES: **What's the Word?** caters to students with learning differences by offering classes specific for these students. Let us know if you are interested in this type of class, as space will be limited.

PRIVATE TUTORING: The curriculum is also offered in flexible, private tutoring that blends seamlessly with the classes. The entire course takes approximately 40 hours to complete privately, depending on the student.
